A tiered system was developed, and the District's dues are capped at \$30,000. Value was added to large districts including the value of the PRESS and including one Board training session at no cost. Additional benefits include meetings twice a year for in-house legal counsel that provide continuing education credit for attendees. The District, on average, reviews approximately fifty policies including the accompanying administrative regulations.
