
"Stay out of the Danger Zone"

Children killed in school bus related crashes most often are the result of either an overtaking and passing vehicle or the bus driver's inability to see the child. Teaching children safe school bus loading, unloading and street crossing practices can save a child's life.



- ✓ Students should enter their school bus according to the diagram above.
- ✓ The *gray area* around the school bus indicates 10 feet. Students should not stand, wait or walk closer than 10 feet to their bus. Bus drivers may not be able to see you in this zone.
- ✓ The <u>red area</u> indicates extreme danger. Students should <u>NEVER</u> enter these extreme dangerous areas around the school bus. Keep in mind the bus driver cannot see you either around the wheels or behind the bus.
